Pediatric ethics is a branch of bioethics that analyzes moral aspects of decisions made relating to the health care of children. In general terms, the autonomy driven framework of adult medical ethics is replaced by a beneficent paternalism (or parentalism) in pediatrics. Pediatric ethics is distinctive because the pediatric clinician has an independent fiduciary obligation to act in a younger child's best interest that takes moral precedence over the wishes of the child's parent (s).

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The decisions of IRBs are informed mainly by ethics, but also science. Additional expertise may be obtained from consultants within or without the institution. Pediatric membership is required from those IRBs that regularly review pediatric research. IRBs consult the literature, and can contact investigators for clarifications.
