Telepractice is viewed as a mode of delivery of health care services, not a separate form of practice. There are no legal prohibitions to using technology in the practice of speech language pathology and audiology, as long as the practice is done by a Washington State licensed practitioner.

Teleaudiology is the utilization of telehealth to provide audiological services that includes full scope of audiologic practice. This type of extended care has been effectively used in many countries as well as by several organizations in the US. Many audiology services translate to telepractice using minimal technology (a computer and a video camera), including aural rehabilitation, hearing aid consultation, hearing aid or cochlear implant troubleshooting, and tinnitus management.
